



FPDS has adjusted our isolation and quarantine procedures. The following are modifications to our earlier protocols:

- **Any student who tests positive for COVID-19** will be required to isolate until five days have passed since symptom onset (or for five days beyond the date of the test if asymptomatic). The student should be symptom-free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever-reducing agent before returning to school or school events.
- **Any student who has contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19** is asked to monitor for symptoms of viral illness including, but not limited to: fever (100.4 degrees or higher), runny nose, sore throat, or cough. Students who remain asymptomatic may continue attending school, but should be monitored for the onset of symptoms. At any point, if the student develops symptoms of concern, the student should isolate at home until he/she is symptom-free for 24 hours without the aid of a fever-reducing agent before returning to school or school events.

We will continue to monitor our numbers and will keep you updated as to any changes. Our goal remains to have on-campus learning in the best environment possible. Please continue to pray for our school, our staff, and our families as we begin our new semester.
